

# How to RECYCLE Responsibly!

Recycling waste materials is easy but can be somewhat confusing. The information below will assist you regarding what can be recycled responsibly. Make sure items are completely empty, clean and dry. Recycling goes a long way for waste material recovery and saves mining, harvesting and drilling natural resources and reduces tons of garbage sent to Coffin Butte landfill.

## **DO RECYCLE**

- PAPER
- CARDBOARD
- GRAY BOARD (cans and bottle boxes)
- ALUMINUM SODA & STEEL/TIN CANS
- ONLY** PLASTIC DRINK BOTTLES & JUGS
- GLASS BEVERAGE BOTTLES
  - a. **NOTE: REMOVE LIDS, CAPS, OR CORKS**

## **DO NOT RECYCLE**

- ANY** FOOD SOILED, GREASY, WAX COATED CARDBOARD
- ANY** FOOD OR DRINK SOILED PAPER
- ANY** PAPER COFFEE CUPS (Starbucks, Dutch Brothers, etc.,
- METALLIC or LAMINATE ASEPTIC CONTAINERS or "BRICK PACKS"
- TOILET PAPER & TISSUE PAPER
- STYROFOAM CUPS, PLATES, FOOD CLAMSHELLS
- PLASTIC BOTTLE CAPS
- PLASTIC FOOD TRAYS
- PLASTIC FOOD CLAMSHELLS
- PLASTIC CUPS
- PLASTIC JARS
- PLASTIC FOOD TUBS
- PLASTIC EATING UTENSILS
- PLASTIC PLATES
- PLASTIC GROCERY BAGS
- DRINKING GLASSES
- WINDOW GLASS
- ANY BROKEN GLASS
- SCRAP METAL
- CAN LIDS UNATTACHED FROM STEEL/TIN CANS
- ALUMINUM FOIL
